

God's Kingdom

- The Jewish concept taught by the Rabbis—"Jews are IN the Kingdom because they were _____ into it, and Gentiles are 'dogs' OUTSIDE of the Kingdom."
- The nation of Israel had been under Gentile domination since 586 BC (with one interlude of independence). They were waiting for Messiah to come and gather the dispersed Jews, usher in God's JUDGMENT on the _____ nations, and re-establish _____ throne to rule the nations.
- The message that Peter preached: JESUS is God's _____! He was crucified, dead and buried and raised the 3rd day! He is coming back and will rescue those who repent and call on His name.

WHEN

40 days + _____ (ten days)

Followed by an unknown amount of time set by the Father

Climaxed by Jesus' Return and the Day of the Lord

FEAST of WEEKS (Shavuot)

One of the three yearly festivals that the Jewish men were to travel to Jerusalem to celebrate.

1. Passover/Feast of Unleavened Bread/Feast of Firstfruits Part A. The barley sheaf was waved in the Temple on the first day after the Passover Sabbath—it was the firstfruits of the harvest to come! 7 Sabbaths + 1 day was counted off = 50 days.
2. Feast of Firstfruits Part B (Shavuot)
3. Feast of Tabernacles

It celebrated the “first crop” and the giving of God’s law on Mt. Sinai.

Now God’s law was being written on the HEARTS of the believers by the Holy Spirit.
