

Isaiah 40 "Comfort, O Comfort My People"

I am the Lord, that is My Name. I will not give my glory to another,
Nor my praise to graven images. Isaiah 42:8

Before Me there was no God formed and there will be none after Me.
I, even I, am the Lord and there is no Savior besides Me. 43:11

I am the first and I am the last, and there is no God besides Me.
Who is like Me? Let him proclaim and declare it...and let them declare to them the things that are
coming and the events that are going to take place.
Do not tremble and do not be afraid; have I not long since announced it to you and declared it? And you
are My witnesses. Is there any God besides Me or is there any other Rock? I know of none. 44:6-8
(falseness of idols. Cyrus mentioned by name and foundation of Temple will be laid.)

I am the Lord, and there is no other. Besides Me there is no God. 45:5
That men may know from the rising to the setting of the sun that there is no one besides Me. I am the
Lord, and there is no other.

For thus says the Lord, who created the heavens..."I am the Lord and there is none else."
Who has announced this from of old? Who has long since declared it? Is it not I, the Lord?
And there is no other god besides Me. A righteous God and a Savior, there is none except Me.
Turn to Me and be saved, all the ends of the earth; For I am God and there is no other. 45:18, 21-22

Remember the former things long past, for I am God and there is no other, I am God and there is no one
like Me. Declaring the end from the beginning, and from ancient times things which have not been
done. Saying, "My purpose will be established and I will accomplish all My good pleasure." 46:9-10

Babylon says in her heart: "I am and there is no one besides me..." 47:8,10
