How to Study a Book of the Bible

Read or listen to the book in one sitting if possible.

(Revelation takes about an hour)

Print out a copy of the book. (Permission from the Lockman Foundation for this study)

Look for repeated words or phrases that show the emphases being taken.

Most mentioned/Least mentioned words

First mentions/Final mentions

Look for summary verses.

How to Study a Book of the Bible (cont.)

**Start with what is known (like putting together the frame of the puzzle first).
Use other Scripture to shed light on the UNKNOWN.**

Look up words in Bible dictionaries or Bible encyclopedias.

Draw initial conclusions in summary form.

Consult conservative commentaries and teachers.

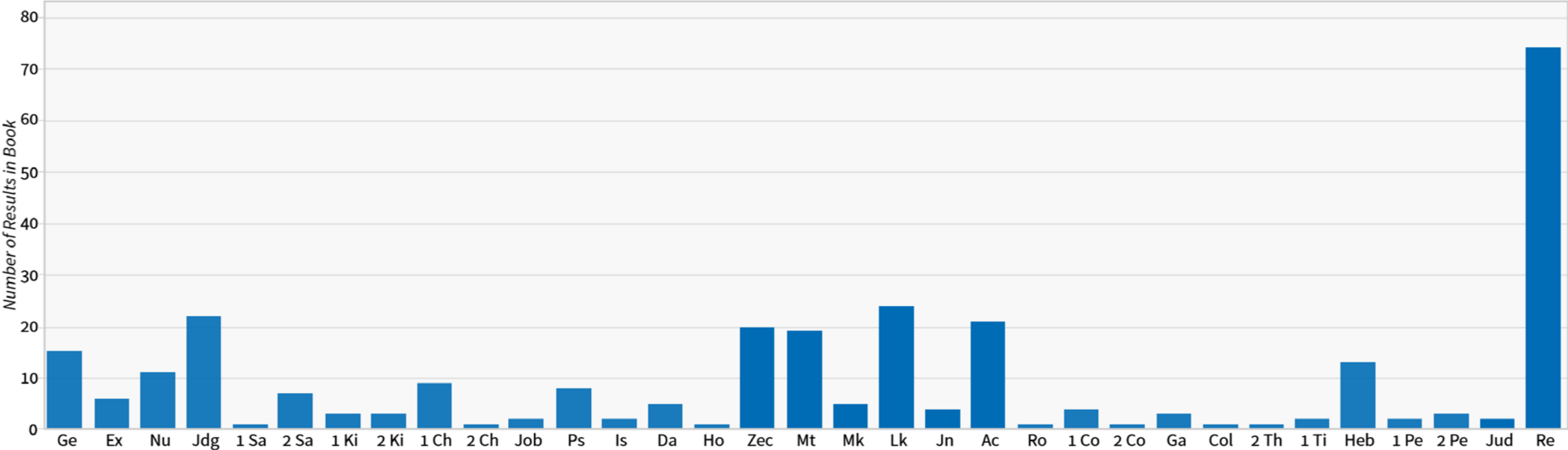

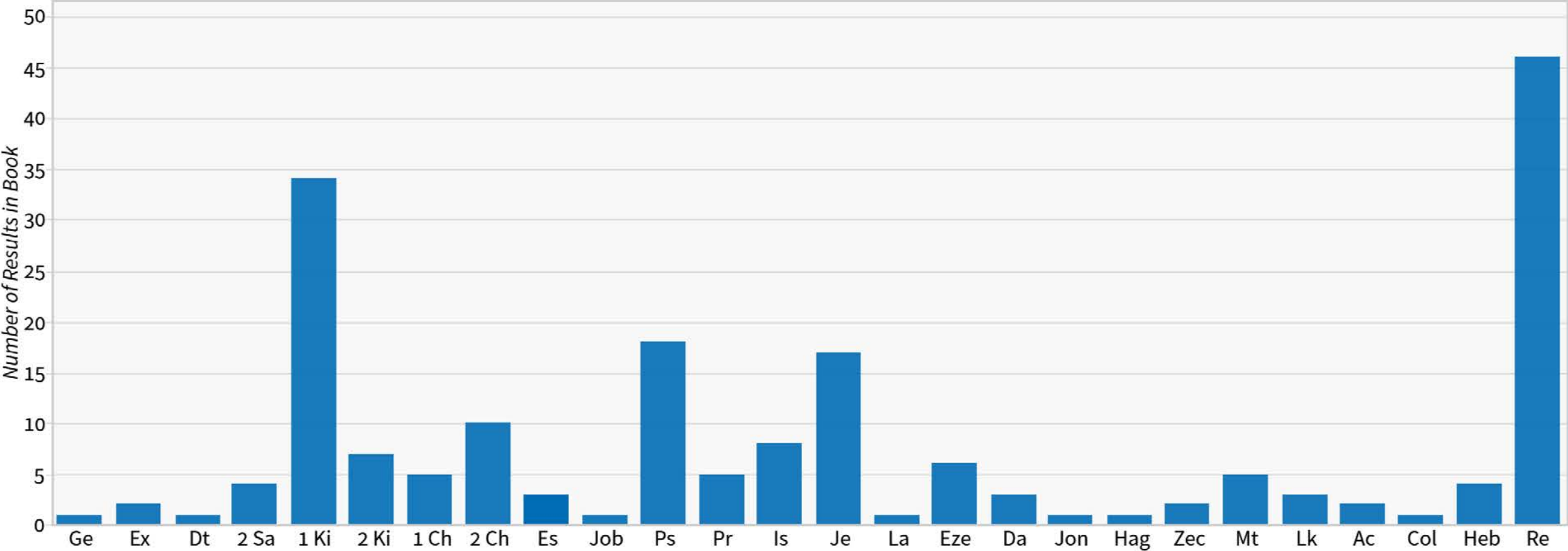

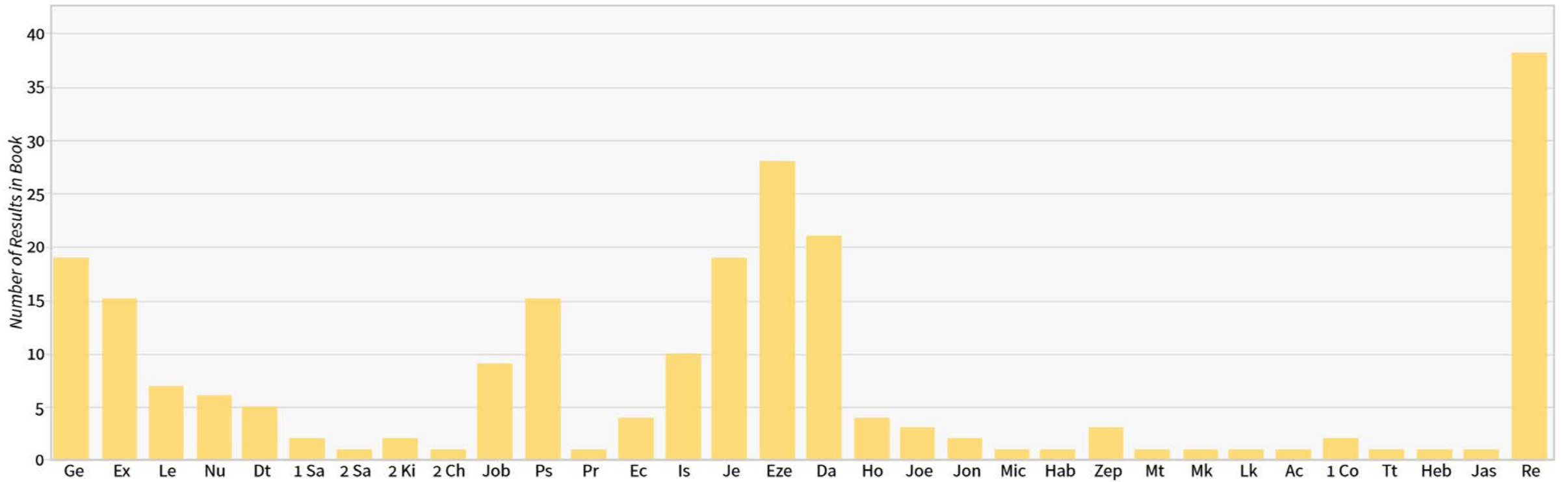
