“Wilderness of Paran: One month out and no meat...” (Num. 10:11-12)


What’s so wrong with a little quail?

- Read Rev. 2:12-14. How was the church at Pergamum like the Israelites at Baal-Peor? What did Jesus tell them to do about it?

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
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
