Memory Verse:

Hebrews 12:5, 11-12

My son, do not regard lightly the discipline of the Lord...
All discipline for the moment seems not to be joyful, but sorrowful;
Yet to those who have been trained by it, afterwards it yields the peaceful
fruit of righteousness.
Therefore, strengthen the hands that are weak
and the knees that are feeble.

Day 1-2

Use a separate sheet of paper (or make a document).

In a column on the left, list in bullet points the things God said in Jeremiah 24 that He would do for the "basket of good figs."

To the right, go through chapters 29-33 and note the verses that refer to the things mentioned in that list.

Day 3-4

Use a separate sheet of paper. In a column on the left, list in bullet points the things God said in Jeremiah 24 that He would do to the "basket of rotten figs."

To the right, go through chapters 34-44 and note the verses that refer to the things mentioned in that list.

Day 5

Read Jeremiah 45-52. Notice that chapter 45 seems to be "out of place."

After reading the chapters, why do you think this was put before the "Nations" section? (take a guess—even if you don't know!! 😊)

Why do you think the book of Jeremiah ends the way it does? (again—think hard and try to put it together with the message from today's lesson.)
