The False Teacher



False teaching matters. The way I can identify false teaching is...


...to know the Scriptures. This takes time, reading, and study.









The Culmination Point in 2015 is where we determine to separate 100% from the Army of the Beast and come into total covenant with the Lamb. The number fifteen means separation. We must separate from all unrighteousness now ... because of the hour we are in.

This year's theme is based on the current climate world-wide and the unfolding of crucial issues – extremely vital to be dealt with personally now. “For from the least of them even to the greatest of them,
Everyone is greedy for gain, And from the prophet even to the priest
Everyone deals falsely. “They have healed the brokenness of My people
superficially, **saying, ‘Peace, peace,’** **But there is no peace.**

Jeremiah 6:13-14

Then the Lord said to me, “The prophets are prophesying falsehood in My name. I have neither sent them nor commanded them nor spoken to them; they are prophesying to you **a false vision, divination, futility and the deception of their own minds.**”

“Also among the prophets of Jerusalem I have seen a horrible thing: **The committing of adultery and walking in falsehood;**
And they strengthen the hands of evildoers, So that **no one has turned back from his wickedness.** All of them have become to Me like Sodom, And her inhabitants like Gomorrah.”

The false prophet is not honest with people about their sin and the consequences of it. They promise there will be no consequences—only God’s peace, love, and safety—even when the person is unrepentant and continues living contrary to God’s explicit words.

The dramatic displays of power draw attention to the false prophet as if the power resides in them, rather than pointing people back to God and showing them their need to repent. True prophets did not claim to have “residual power” within themselves. (note: Joseph/Daniel)



- Those living for themselves, according to their own understanding and desires, are under God's Judgment.
- There is pardon for those who turn from their own way and receive Jesus. "I'm a sinner. I need a Savior."
- Holiness is to characterize the life of the true follower of Jesus, demonstrated by actions. Holiness comes from Jesus and staying close to Him. This is a GROWING process.

“Jesus told them another parable: “The kingdom of heaven is like a man who sowed good seed in his field. ²⁵ But while everyone was sleeping, **his enemy** came and sowed tares among the wheat, and went away. ²⁶ When the wheat sprouted and formed heads, then the tares also appeared.

²⁷ “The owner’s servants came to him and said, ‘Sir, didn’t you sow good seed in your field? **Where then did the tares come from?**’

²⁸ “**An enemy** did this,’ he replied.

“The servants asked him, ‘Do you want us to go and pull them up?’

²⁹ “‘No,’ he answered, ‘because while you are pulling the weeds, you may uproot the wheat with them. ³⁰ Let both grow together until the harvest. At that time I will tell the harvesters: First collect the tares and tie them in bundles to be burned; then gather the wheat and bring it into my barn.’”

Then he left the crowd and went into the house. His disciples came to him and said, “Explain to us the parable of the weeds in the field.”

³⁷ He answered, “The one who sowed the good seed is the Son of Man. ³⁸ The field is the world, and the good seed stands for **the people of the kingdom**. The weeds are **the people of the evil one**, ³⁹ and the enemy who sows them is the devil. The harvest is the end of the age, and the harvesters are angels.


How do you recognize the decoy?

BEWARE of the MINISTRY DECOY!




Definition:

The “Christian” or “unbeliever” that the believer has a *natural connection with* and *wants* to spend time with. They use ‘ministering to them’ as the reason they are spending time with that person.

They may truly believe they are ministering to that person and not see it for what it truly is. This sheep is naïve and deceived.

Hooks into subtle, but false beliefs:



"I'm the only true believer this person has."

"They won't hear about Jesus from anyone else."

"If they accept me, they will accept Jesus."

"If I do what they do, it will show them they aren't condemned."

"My love and friendship with them will lead them to salvation."

"I'm not affected by __, therefore I can be around it and participate freely in what they are doing."

Treat a wolf and wolf in sheep's clothing the same.

"I'm not a believer."




A true follower submits to the authority of Scripture and wants to be obedient to Jesus. Wolves do not speak truthfully about the Scriptures, and do not submit to its authority.
