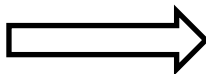
The Care of the Wilderness

2. Will He provide what I need?

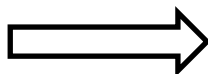


Answer Key:

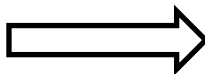

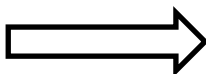
