Genesis 23-50

As Abraham's family tree grew, not everyone wanted to hold the promises the way he had. Read Genesis 25:24-34. Why did his grandson, Esau, act as if the promises that Abraham had received were of no use to him?

From Genesis 28:13 list all the things God promised Jacob He would do. What guarantee does Jacob want before he agrees that God will be "his" God?

At what point in your life did God become more than just the "God of your fathers" and become personal to you?

Exodus-Deuteronomy

Although the Israelites had absorbed the idolatrous culture of the Egyptians during their stay in Egypt, God wanted to "buy them back" for Himself. From Exodus 12:1-13, what was the Israelites part in assuring their firstborn would be spared from the death that was going to come on every firstborn in the land?

How would a person "apply the blood" today in order to be passed over in judgment?

In Exodus 19:4, God said he carried His people on eagles' wings during their time traveling to Mt. Sinai. Why did the Israelites have such a hard time keeping their agreement to obey God?

Does God expect you to keep His laws? How well do you do?
