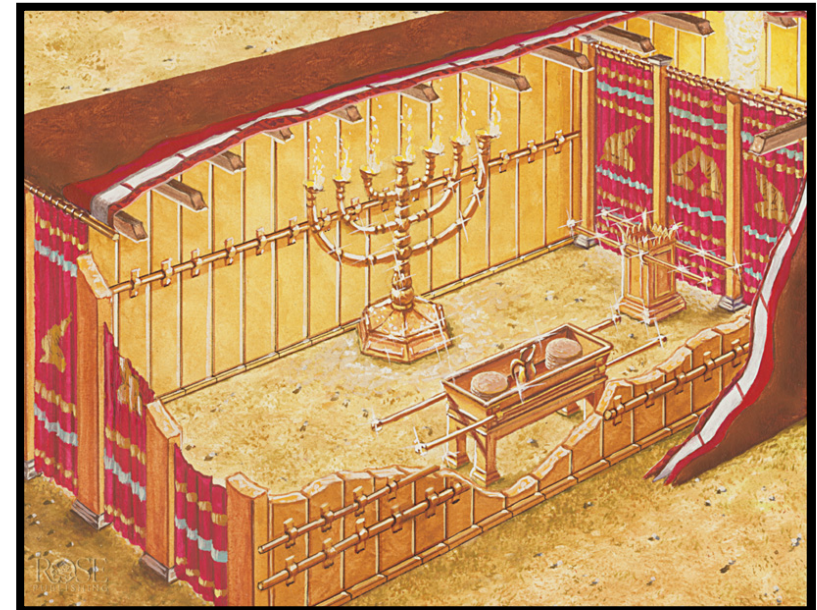
1. The Lampstand

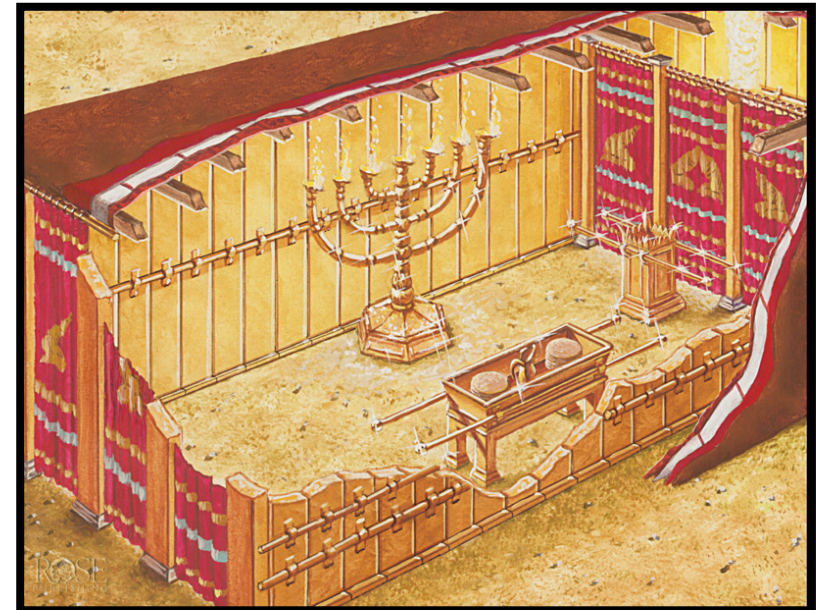
