

Scriptures for Overview of the Bible

Genesis 2:16-17 And the LORD God commanded the man, "You are free to eat from any tree in the garden; but you must not eat from the tree of the knowledge of good and evil, for when you eat from it **you will certainly die.**"

Genesis 3:4 "**You will not certainly die,**" the serpent said to the woman.

Genesis 12:1-3 The LORD had said to Abram, "Go from your country, your people and your father's household to the land I will show you. **"I will** make you into a great nation, and **I will** bless you; **I will** make your name great, and you will be a blessing. **I will** bless those who bless you, and whoever curses you **I will** curse; and all peoples on earth will be blessed through you."

Genesis 22:2,8,14 Then God said, "Take your son, your only son, whom you love—Isaac—and go to the **region of Moriah**. Sacrifice him there as a burnt offering on a mountain I will show you."

Abraham answered (Isaac), "God himself will provide the lamb for the burnt offering, my son."

So Abraham called that place The LORD Will Provide. And to this day it is said, "On the mountain of the LORD it will be provided."

Exodus 12:13 "On that same night I will pass through Egypt and strike down every firstborn of both people and animals, and I will bring judgment on all the gods of Egypt. I am the LORD. The blood will be a sign for you on the houses where you are, and **when I see the blood, I will pass over you.**"

Exodus 20:2,3 "I am the LORD your God, who brought you out of Egypt, out of the land of slavery. You shall have **no other gods** before me."

I Samuel 8:7 And the LORD told him: "Listen to all that the people are saying to you; it is not you they have rejected, but **they have rejected me** as their king."

II Samuel 7:8-9,11-12,16 "Now then, tell my servant David, 'This is what the LORD Almighty says: I took you from the pasture, from tending the flock, and appointed you ruler over my people Israel...Now **I will** make your name great, like the names of the greatest men on earth... 'The LORD declares to you that the LORD himself will establish a house for you...**I will** raise up your offspring to succeed you, your own flesh and blood, and **I will** establish his kingdom...Your house and your kingdom will **endure forever** before me; your throne will be established forever.'"

II Chronicles 3:1 Then Solomon began to build the temple of the LORD in Jerusalem on **Mount Moriah**, where the LORD had appeared to his father David.

Ezekiel 34:11,16,23 "'For this is what the Sovereign LORD says: I myself will search for my sheep and look after them...**I will search for the lost** and bring back the strays. I will bind up the injured and strengthen the weak, but the sleek and the strong I will destroy. I will shepherd the flock with justice...I will place over them **one shepherd, my servant David**, and he will tend them; he will tend them and be their shepherd.

Malachi 3:1 "I will send my messenger, who will prepare the way before me. Then suddenly **the Lord you are seeking will come** to his temple; the messenger of the covenant, whom you desire, will come," says the LORD Almighty.

Matthew 1:1 This is the genealogy of Jesus the Messiah the **son of David**, the son of **Abraham**.

Luke 19:10 "For the Son of Man came to **seek and to save the lost**."

John 10:10-11 "The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy; I have come that they may have life, and have it to the full. **I am the good shepherd. The good shepherd lays down his life** for the sheep."

John 19:30 When he had received the drink, Jesus said, "**It is finished**." With that, he bowed his head and gave up his spirit.

Acts 1:8 "But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and **you will be my witnesses** in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, **and to the ends of the earth**."

II Peter 1:3 His divine power has given us **everything we need for a godly life** through our knowledge of him who called us by his own glory and goodness.

Revelation 20:2,10 He seized the dragon, that ancient serpent, who is the devil, or **Satan**, and bound him for a thousand years. And the devil, who deceived them, **was thrown into the lake of burning sulfur**...

Revelation 20:12,15 And I saw the dead, great and small, standing before the throne, and books were opened. Another book was opened, which is the book of life. **The dead were judged** according to what they had done as recorded in the books... **Anyone whose name was not found written in the book of life was thrown into the lake of fire**.

Revelation 21:1,3-4 Then I saw **a new heaven and a new earth**, for the first heaven and the first earth had passed away, and there was no longer any sea... And I heard a loud voice from the throne saying, "Look! God's dwelling place is now among the people, and he will dwell with them. They will be his people, and God himself will be with them and be their God. He will wipe every tear from their eyes. **There will be no more death or mourning or crying or pain**, for the old order of things has passed away."

Revelation 22:12,20 "**Look, I am coming soon!** My reward is with me, and I will give to each person according to what they have done. I am the Alpha and the Omega, the First and the Last, the Beginning and the End. He who testifies to these things says, "**Yes, I am coming soon**." Amen. Come, Lord Jesus.
