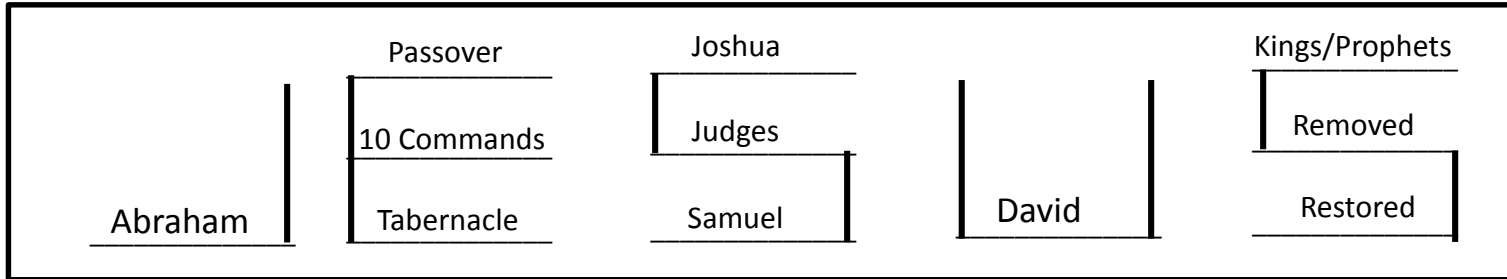

What the Old Testament shows, the New Testament **magnifies**.

"You have heard that the ancients were told, 'YOU SHALL NOT COMMIT MURDER'...

*But I say to you that everyone who is angry with his brother shall be guilty before the court; and whoever says to his brother, 'You good-for-nothing,' shall be guilty before the supreme court; and whoever says, 'You fool,' shall be guilty enough to go into the fiery hell.*

"You have heard that it was said, 'YOU SHALL NOT COMMIT ADULTERY'...

*But I say to you that everyone who looks at a woman with lust for her has already committed adultery with her in his heart.*

"That which proceeds out of the man, that is what defiles the man. For from within, out of the heart of men, proceed the evil thoughts, fornications, thefts, murders, adulteries, deeds of coveting and wickedness, as well as deceit, sensuality, envy, slander, pride and foolishness. All these evil things proceed from within and defile the man." Mark 7:21-23

1. God is holy, but comes down to earth to live with His people. *"The Word became flesh and **dwelt** among us..." John 1:14*

2. People are unholy, and Judgment against lawbreakers is real. *"But because of your stubbornness and unrepentant heart you are storing up wrath for yourself in the day of wrath and revelation of the righteous judgment of God." Romans 2:5*

3. There is one way to come to God:

*"I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father but through Me." John 14:6*  
*All that the Father gives Me will come to Me, and the one who comes to Me I will certainly not cast out.* John 6:37

4. in humility, trusting in the blood (death/life) of His appointed sacrifice.

*"He who believes in the Son has eternal life; but he who does not obey the Son will not see life, but the wrath of God abides on him." John 3:36*  
*If you confess with your mouth Jesus as Lord, and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved.* Romans 10:9-10

5. Only God's designated representative can mediate for a guilty person before God.

*For there is one God, and one mediator also between God and men, the man Christ Jesus. I Timothy 2:5*  
*we have such a high priest, who has taken His seat at the right hand of the throne of the Majesty in the heavens, a minister in the sanctuary and in the true tabernacle, which the Lord pitched, not man.* Hebrews 8:1-2

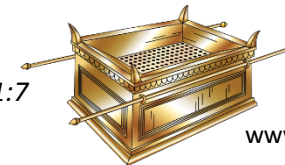
7. The servants of God must be clean in order to fellowship with God and serve Him.
